

## TERM 2 FREE EXCURSION: *LEARN ABOUT LANDSCAPES*

Introduce your students to the artform of landscapes by booking in for our **free** excursion package! This excursion will begin with a guided tour of our [Landscape Tells the Way](#) and [Shifting Ground](#) exhibitions. Students will learn about what a landscape artwork is and what materials artists use to create landscape artworks. For older students, a discussion on how landscapes reflect a time and place with emphasis on historical and contemporary art practices.

The tour will be followed by hands-on workshop using air-dry clay. Students will learn coil and building techniques to create a vessel.

### BOOKING DETAILS

**Excursion:** 1-hour guided tour of exhibitions: *Landscape Tells the Way* and *Shifting Ground*. 1-hour mixed media landscape workshop. Total time is 2 hours although 15 to 30-minute breaks in between each activity can be included upon request.

**Students:** Suitable for students in Years 3 - 6 in Primary School and Years 7 & 8 High School Visual Art Students.

**Cost:** Free

**Numbers:** Maximum number of students per excursion is 30. \*\*If the group is larger than 30, we can rotate this excursion with another activity such as a tour of other exhibitions (tours are free).

**Dates:** Bookings can be made on any Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday within Term 2. The Gallery is closed to the public on Mondays.
