

Task: In this artwork Pamela Griffith has painted people having fun. The people in this painting are skydiving and they are using a parachute to do this. Let's make our fun parachute artwork like Pamela Griffith.




MATERIALS:

- Patty cake cases
 String or wool
 Coloured markers
- Blue & yellow paint
 A4 piece of paper or thin card
- Paint brush
 Water container & water
 Glue stick
 Scissors

Using yellow paint and your paintbrush, paint a yellow strip at the bottom of your page. This will be the sand in your artwork.

Using blue paint and your paintbrush, paint the rest of your artwork blue. This will be the sky in your artwork. Now you will have to wait till this is dry to finish your artwork.

Fold your patty cake cases in half and colour one side using your markers. These will be your parachute in your artwork.



Glue your parachute patty cake cases onto your artwork when it is dry.

Glue Stick

• Ideal for paper, fabric, photos etc

• Washable

Cut 3 x pieces of string for each parachute in your artwork. Make each piece of string about 5cm long. Glue them down to your artwork.



Using a marker draw your people parachuting down. You now have finished your own fun parachute artwork.
